APLEC Conference 2013

The 2013 APLEC Conference is being jointly hosted by Flinders Law School and the Law Society of South Australia/Adelaide Law School. The conference will be held at the Flinders University City Campus, 182 Victoria Square.

Conference Theme

The Conference is inspired by George Bernard Shaw's quote: "*If you have an apple and I have an apple and we exchange these apples then you and I will still each have one apple. But if you have an idea and I have an idea and we exchange these ideas, then each of us will have two ideas.*" Exchange² metaphorically describes the synergy of APLEC delegates joining together at Victoria Square to exchange ideas.

Keynote Address

Programmatic assessment for learning

Lambert Schuwirth, Professor of Medical Education, Flinders Innovations in Clinical Education, School of Medicine, Flinders University

Traditionally assessment is associated with testing, or, more precisely, testing of the outcome of the learning process. This is often referred to as assessment OF learning. More recent developments try to incorporate the notion that assessment can - and probably should - be designed to form an integral part of the learning process rather than merely an extraneous process. Expertise research suggests that this would lead to better learning, deeper understanding and higher levels of expertise. Such assessment FOR learning, however, requires a considerable reconsideration of the culture and concepts of assessment. Within the context of medical education such reconsiderations are taking place with exciting new insights and developments. In my presentation I want to describe them and discuss them to see where parallels exist and where the legal education and medical education fields can learn from each other.



Plenary Session

PLT Placements and the Fair Work Act

Professor Andrew Stewart, Adelaide Law School

Adelaide Law School Professors Rosemary Owens and Andrew Stewart co-authored the Fair Work Ombudsman's report 'The nature and prevalence of unpaid work experience, internships and trial periods in Australia. Experience or Exploitation' of January 2013. The report examines three categories of unpaid work; unpaid trial work, unpaid internships and other forms of unpaid work experience. Professor Stewart will consider the implications of the report findings in the context of legal practice placements as part of a practical legal training programme.
